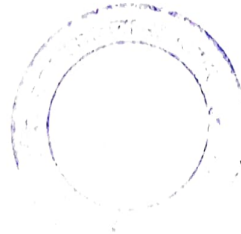

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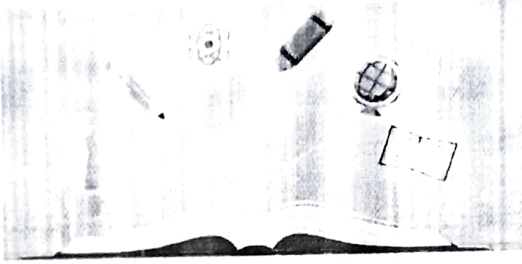

Abstract-1

This paper will present a public policy proposal for the economic empowerment of women which aims to initiate a bill for tax deductions in the private sector, depending on the share of women from vulnerable groups who have advanced in their careers, after the moment of employment, thanks to the actions of the Annual Action Plan for the career development, implemented at the private entity level. In this sense, it is essential to implement various ways to ensure the achievement of SDG 5 - Gender equality, in correlation with SDG 8 - Decent work and economic growth and with SDG 10 - Reduced inequalities. It also introduces greater diversity of thought to the workplace, driving innovation and profitability. It is notable that, by reducing income inequality, economic growth can be stimulated.

States are basically formed for the protection and provision of human security, welfare of her citizens and the environment, every other functions of the state revolves around the ones mentioned above. Nigeria is witnessing high rate of insecurity for the past two decades and all efforts to combat insecurity proved futile. The paper examined human security and sustainable development in Nigeria, In retrospect and prospect for sustainable development. The paper made use of secondary data and content analysis used objectively to analyze data while Aristotle theory of state adopted as the theoretical framework. The study unveiled that Nigerian government has failed to provide the basic necessity of life for her citizens. That state institutions, instrumentalities and apparatus are weak, working at variance with state categorical duty. The failure of the state to provide human security has led to internal crises, frictions, and other anti-social behaviors and vices that breed frictions. This diametrically transmogrified to excruciating features of underdevelopment and invitation of anarchy. Factors that negate state from performing her basic roles were mentioned and factors threatening human security in Nigeria listed. The nexus between human security and sustainable explained. Consequently the following commendations were made on how the state can achieve and maintained human security which includes,
